## Understanding

S understands R(a,b,c) at time t can be defined simply as:

$(\exists w)(\exists x)(\exists y)(\exists z)$

- & Symbol\_1r(S,t,w,R)
- & Symbol\_0r(S,t,x,a)
- & Symbol\_0r(S,t,y,b)
- & Symbol\_0r(S,t,z,c)

Belief implies understanding.
